AIR-FRIED CRACKLINS

Makes 4 to 6 servings

INGREDIENTS

- · I pound pork belly cut into I-inch pieces
- · I tbsp. Cajun seasoning
- ½ tsp. baking soda

INSTRUCTIONS

 In a large bowl, combine pork belly, Cajun seasoning, and baking soda, stirring until well coated.

- 2. Preheat air fryer to 250° F.
- Arrange the pork belly in an even layer in an air fryer. Cook for 15 to 20 minutes. Turn pork belly chunks.
- 4. Increase temperature to 400° F. Cook, shaking air fryer basket occasionally, until golden brown and crispy, 15 to 20 minutes. Serve hot.


